

1880 FEDERAL MORTALITY SCHEDULE FOR

MUSKEGON COUNTY, MICHIGAN

The Federal government began taking mortality schedules in conjunction with the Federal census in 1850. The previous mortality schedules for Muskegon County have been published in Family Tree Talks. The mortality information was taken on a separate schedule from the population schedule; however, the number of the family unit on the regular population schedule appears with the death record of the person from that family. Therefore, by going back to the regular schedule you can find out more information, such as parents or children, of those who died.

Information provided the census enumerator included name, sex, age, color, married or widowed, place of birth, place of birth of father and mother, month in which the death occurred, profession or occupation, disease or cause of death, and how long the deceased was a resident of the county. The name of the doctor who attended the deceased, when applicable, is the last item in the enumeration.

The deaths listed below occurred within the twelve month period previous to the taking of the census only, or from 1 June 1879 through 31 May 1880. Some of these deaths do not have a Michigan death record maintained by the county clerk, therefore, in some instances these citations are the only record available.

The abbreviations used for place of birth are identical to the standards established in the Michigan Surname Index.
